Dear Kardinal Athletic Family,

The Governor has recently signed Executive Order #220 giving school districts discretion to allow 2 parents/guardians per student athlete to attend High School athletic events. The indoor gathering limit still applies which continues to be inclusive of all coaches, players, officials, and now spectators. I am happy to inform you that the Kearny School Districts has decided to permit 2 parents/guardians to attend varsity events at Kearny High School. Compliance with all NJ Department of Health guidelines for sports activities must be followed, which includes, but is not limited to, required face coverings, social distancing at all times, staying home if not feeling well, etc. For your reference, NJ DOH Guidance for Sports can be found at:

Below is a list of guidelines to be followed if attending an event:

- Only parents/guardians of student athletes on a predetermined list will be admitted
- Spectators must provide a completed prescreening questionnaire, which will be provided to the predetermined guests via email, and complete a temperature check by the Site Manager prior to entry.
- Spectators will be permitted to enter 10 minutes prior to game time and must leave immediately at its conclusion. Gathering with athletes or coaches at the conclusion of an event is not permissible.
- Spectators must wear masks at all times and sit 6 feet apart in approved seating areas which will be clearly marked.
- No food or beverages are permitted.
- Events at Kearny high School will continue to be Livestreamed.
- Spectators are expected to demonstrate good sportsmanship to all participants throughout the event and follow the direction of the site management team.

The Kearny School District does not control the policies of independent sites where athletic contests are held. Details that apply to Ice Hockey and Bowling will be shared with those teams and parents.

We will continue to strive to provide our student athletes a safe environment with opportunities to participate in athletics and develop into productive citizens in our community. Thank you for your cooperation throughout these challenging times.
