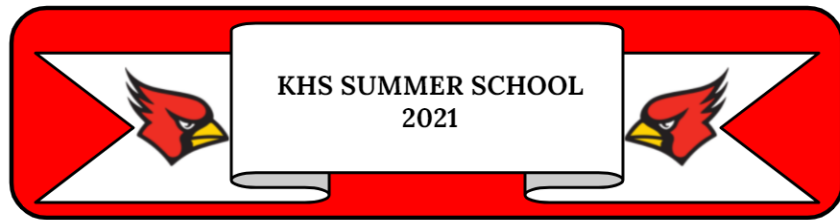

The State of New Jersey mandates a MINIMUM of 60 hours of coursework in order to obtain credit in a summer school program. Failure to complete the required hours as directed by the teacher WILL result in no credit being given to the student.

COURSE OFFERINGS

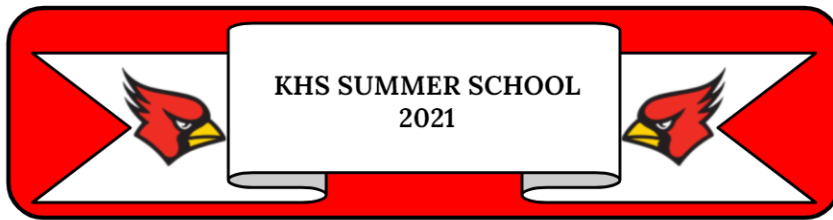
Remedial Courses

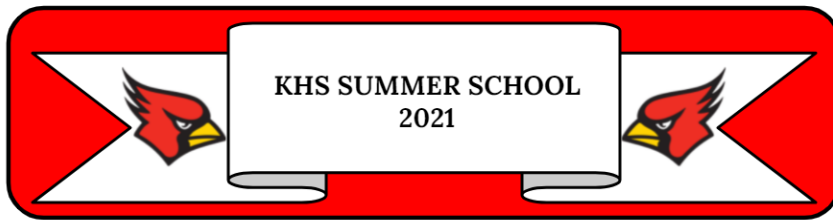

SUMMER SCHOOL INFORMATION

KHS 2021 Summer School will have both an in person and virtual option through the use of Google Classroom and Edgenuity. Please note the following information and expectations for the program.

- Students will need daily access to their school issued Chromebooks
 - If a student has an issue with a Chromebook, please email Mr. Savage and he will provide further instruction. Chromebook repair will be available throughout the summer, but will be limited.
- Students will be enrolled into one of two sessions. That session will be determined by the number of students that enroll.
- Students will need to check their Kearny Schools email on a regular basis.
- Students **MUST** check their email on **TUESDAY, June 29th**. An email will be sent to the parent/guardian and to the student with details about the student's class(es) information.
 - Included in that email will be the following
 - The subject the student is taking
 - The time the course will take place
 - The teacher
 - The Google Classroom code for that course
 - Once students receive this email, they should log into Google Classroom and enter the class using the code. The student's must use their given Kearny Schools email address.
- Students will be required to complete an attendance form daily.
 - This form will be posted daily on the classpage.
 - If a student is taking two classes, an attendance form should be completed for EACH class.
 - Daily Attendance is MANDATORY. If you fail to attend class, you may not receive credit for the class, regardless of the work completed.
 - If there is an emergency, and you can not attend class at the correct time, please email both the teacher and Mr. Savage (jsavage@kearnyschools.com).
 - Students are expected to complete ALL work given by the teacher throughout the duration of the course.
 - Teachers will be available through email and Google Classroom during the allotted time the class meets. During that time, teachers can/will:
 - Meet with the entire class to provide whole group instruction.
 - Meet with an individual student to provide personalized instruction.
 - Answer student/parent emails pertaining to student work and progress.



- Students will receive grades for their work as they would during the regular school year. Students will need a minimum of a 65 average for the course in order to obtain credit.
