

GENERAL INFORMATION

TUITION – Each course will have the fee listed within the course description.

REGISTRATION – (1) by mail or (2) in person on February 18, 19, and 20 at 6:30-8:30 pm at KHS

(1) You are urged to register by mail using the form that is found in our registration section. All checks or money orders should be made payable to Kearny Adult School. The form and your payment should be mailed to Kearny High School, 336 Devon Street, Kearny, NJ 07032 attention Mr. Patrick Cassidy.

(2) In person registration is on February 18, 19, and 20 between 6:30-8:30 pm at Kearny High School. Students should be prepared to pay in full for their course. Accepted payment is cash, check or money order only. Credit cards or debit are not accepted.

REFUND POLICY – Tuition will only be refunded for the following reasons:
